Language Arts Curriculum

History Curriculum

As students strive to master the Common Core standards in History-Social Science, they will be working with multiple texts focused on geography, Rome, Islam, West Africa, Asia, Europe, and the Americas. Students will study the social, cultural, and technological changes that occurred in the years A.D. 500-1789, and examine how societies developed and fell apart.

Grading Policy

The grading policy for 7th grade ELA and History will be posted on Infinite Campus. Our grading for ELA and History will primarily focus on the progress students make on the priority standards we are covering throughout the year. We want students to see value in continuing to work on standards that they may not have been successful with the first time around.

I want the students to know that percentages and letter grades CAN change based on their progress towards success on prioritized standards that they will have multiple opportunities to show proficiency.
