
What We Will Learn in ELA

Students will be exposed to a variety of texts and genres using a teacher created curriculum where they will practice reading comprehension and analysis. Students will also compose multiple essays of varying purposes – such as narrative, informational, and argumentative. A great emphasis will be placed on research and using textual evidence from readings to compose pieces of writing. Students will increase their vocabulary in depth in order to communicate effectively to their peers.




Grades for these courses will be updated on Infinite Campus every Monday night. Students and parents can log in to check grades and progress in the classes. I can print a physical copy of grades by request.
